Paired Review:

Paired review activities help students understand the importance of reflecting upon and personalizing their learning, it encourages review to help students better understand and remember what they are learning.

Targeted Reading Levels: 2nd grade-college

Major Focus: Comprehension

Procedure:

- ❖ The student should approach the material that they have learned like they were an expert, explaining the information to someone who is not knowledgeable of the subject.
- ❖ The student must explain it so that the other person can understand it.
- ❖ Any unfamiliar vocabulary and concepts must be translated so that it makes sense to their partner.
- ❖ The partner will ask the expert any clarifying questions, and repeat the information taught to verify that they understood the information given by the expert.
- ❖ The student can then find someone else to teach the material to for further review.
