Verbatim Split Page Procedure (VSPP)

VSPP

A great study strategy that helps students with recall, retention, and acquisition of information. This helps student's develop their own system of taking notes and find the note taking process that works best for them.

This is a tool that helps student's take notes during lectures and organize their notes in a way that these notes will be helpful later.

Description:

This is a procedure that teaches students how to take effective notes during lectures.

Targeted Reading Level:

7th-College

Major Focus:

Organization and Comprehension

Procedure:

Students divide a paper with a 60/40 fold. (Left side 40% and the right side 60%)

Students use the left side (40%) to take notes during lectures.

Notes should be taken as to what the lecturer said verbatim, but brief and clipped. (this is Short words should be clarified and revised to be whole words, phrases and sentences to make notes clear for future use.
