Reading Assignments: For Unit I and First Exam, read Chapters 17-21. For Unit II and Second Exam, read Chapters 22-26. For Unit III and Third Exam, read Chapters 27-28 and for Unit IV and the Comprehensive Final Exam, read Chapters 29-32.

Examinations: There will be four exams. See the schedule on the next page for dates of each exam and the final exam. Exams will include multiple choice and short answer questions. Exam questions will be taken from the lectures and textbook reading assignments. Each exam will be worth 100 points. Grades on tests will be determined by a percentage of the points possible. Your final grade will be determined by a percentage of the total points possible. (400 points will be possible) All grades are based on the following scale: 90-100=A, 80-89=B, 70-79=C, 60-69=D, Below 60=F.

Makeup Exams: Each student is expected to be present for every exam at the appointed time. If you miss an exam, you will be expected to make arrangements to take a makeup exam. Makeup exams will be essay rather than multiple choice and short answer. A makeup exam should be taken before the next regularly scheduled exam.

Bonus: A bonus assignment will be given on November 20. You must attend class that day to receive the bonus assignment. This assignment will worth a maximum of 15 bonus points and will be due at the next class meeting on November 25.

Attendance: There is no substitute for regular attendance. Students with poor attendance seldom do well. Attendance will be taken at each class meeting. You must attend the entire class period to be counted present. Except for approved activities, there will be no excused absences. Class attendance will be used to determine borderline course grades (59%, 69%, 79%, 89%). If you accumulate no more than 1 absence, borderline grades will be rounded up to the next higher grade. Three tardies will be considered 1 absence.

Withdrawals: Students who withdraw from the class prior to the deadline indicated in the class schedule will receive a grade of "W". Students who withdraw from the class after the deadline will receive a "W" if they are passing the course on the date of withdrawal. Students who withdraw after the deadline and are not passing on the date of withdrawal will receive and "F". Exceptions can be made at the discretion of the instructor.
