Suggested School Supply List 2006 - 2007

THE MAP CLASS

Mrs. Avery and Mrs. Thompson

- 12 each No. 2 pencils
- 1 each pink eraser
- 3 boxes crayons (**24 count only**, nothing larger PLEASE, Crayola has the best color)
- 1 box markers (**CLASSIC COLOR**, not fine point)
- 1 each bottle glue (4 oz.)
- 4 each glue sticks
- 1 each scissors (metal blades work better than plastic, like Fiskars for kids)
- 1 box watercolors (Prang brand has the best color)
- 2 each school boxes
- 2 pkgs. notebook paper (**WIDE-RULE ONLY**, no college-rule)
- 10 each **PLAIN, pocket folders with brads (NO DESIGNS, MEAD brand lasts longer)**
- 2 boxes tissue
- 1 **SMALL** backpack (large backpacks & ones with wheels don't usually fit in the very small lockers)

We hope that you and your child will attend the Open House in August and bring school supplies. We will help you put names on supplies at that time. This really helps the first day of school run smoother if we can take care of supplies **BEFORE** school begins.

PLEASE DO NOT put names on the following items: pencils, folders, notebook paper, school boxes, and tissues.

It would really help us if you would like to choose one of the following items to donate to school for us to use in the classroom with the children.

- Wal-Mart gift certificate (used for film and developing)
- antibacterial kitchen cleaning spray (not air freshener)
- Bounty paper towels
- 1 gallon freezer bags with SLIDE zip top
- paper plates
- cotton balls
