A major in sociology requires 37 hours of course work. At least 18 hours of advanced (3000 or 4000 level) courses are required in the sociology major. At least eighteen hours of this major must be earned at NSU. Majors in sociology must have 2.0 GPA for all required (core) courses in the major. This degree is only offered on the Tahlequah campus.
