

**B.S., CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
COP  
COLLEGIATE OFFICER PROGRAM**

The B.S., Criminal Justice is available during both the day and evening patterns (see sequence on reverse side). At least 20 hours of advanced (3000/4000) courses are required on the Criminal Justice major. Sixty hours must be earned from a four-year institution. Fifty percent (20 hours) of this program must be NSU-earned credit. This program requires 55 hours of liberal arts and, together with general education from NSU, provides 60 hours.
